POINT NO.6 ---- FACILITIES PROVIDED TO THE CHILDREN INSIDE JAIL:-

CHILDREN ARE KEPT IN CRECHE FROM 9 AM TO 5 PM, WHERE HOMELY ENVIRONMENT IS GIVEN TO THEM. ALL FACILITIES ARE PROVIDED TO THE CHILDREN LIKE EDUCATION, MEDICAL, FOOD(VEGETABLES, FRUITS, MILK, RATION) AND CLOTHES. ONCE A MONTH, BIRTHDAY OF CHILDREN IS CELEBRATED AND TWICE A MONTH, CAKE IS PROVIDED FROM TAJ THROUGH INDIA VISION FOUNDATION. TOYS, STORY BOOKS, SOAP, CREAM, POWDER AND OIL ARE ALSO PROVIDED TO THEM. OTHER VARIOUS ACTIVITIES LIKE GAMES, FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS AND OUTSIDE PICNICS ARE ALSO ORGANISED BY THE INDIA VISION FOUNDATION FOR THE CHILDREN. ON REACHING THE AGE OF 6+ YEARS, A CHILD IS REGISTERED UNDER PROJECT AND SENT TO DIFFERENT MAINSTREAM RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL WITH WHICH FOUNDATION HAS COLLABORATION.

POINT NO. 7-- - TOTAL NUMBER OF SR. CITIZENS IN JAILS AS ON 31st MAY 2015 (AT MORNING LOCK UP) = 386 (Above 60 years)

POINT NO.8 ---- FACILITIES PROVIDED TO THE SENIOR CITIZEN INSIDE JAIL

1. SENIOR CITIZENS ARE PROVIDED WITH BEDS.
2. INMATE TELEPHONE FACILITY IS INSTALLED IN THEIR WARD.
3. SENIOR CITIZENS ARE LODGED IN WARD WHICH IS CLOSE TO CENTRAL JAIL HOSPITAL FOR MEDICAL EXIGENCY.
4. WARM WATER IS PROVIDED FOR BATH.
5. PORAGE (DALIA) AND SOFT DIET IS AVAILABLE FOR MEALS.
6. SPECIAL DIET WHICH INCLUDES FRUITS, MILK, EGGS AND BUTTER IS PROVIDED AS AND WHEN IT IS PRESCRIBED BY THE DOCTOR.
7. SENIOR CITIZENS ARE ALSO PROVIDED WITH WARD SAHAYAKS FOR HELP.
8. FOR RECREATION, TV WITH CABLE CONNECTION ARE INSTALLED IN THEIR BARRACKS.
9. SENIOR CITIZENS ARE REFERRED FROM TIME TO TIME TO GOVT. HOSPITAL FOR COMPLETE CHECKUP AND SPECILISED TREATMENT WITH REGULAR FOLLOW UPS.
